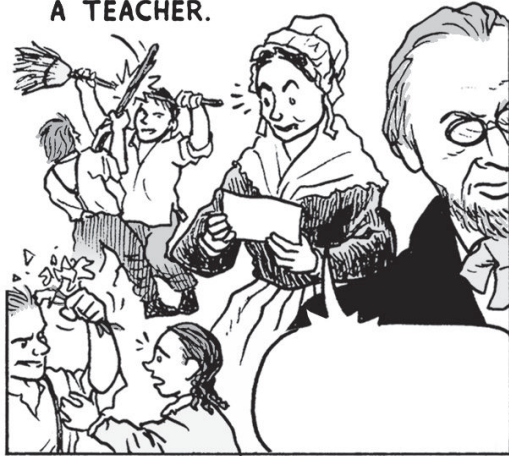


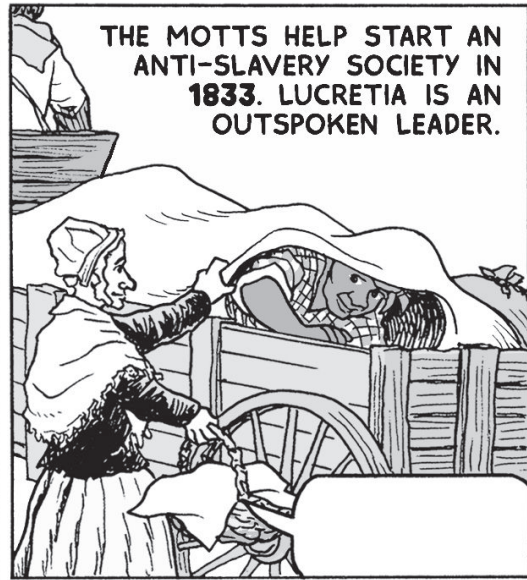

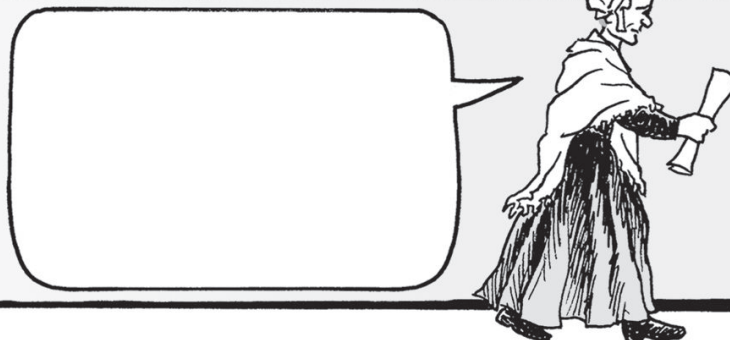
LUCRETIA COFFIN IS BORN 1793

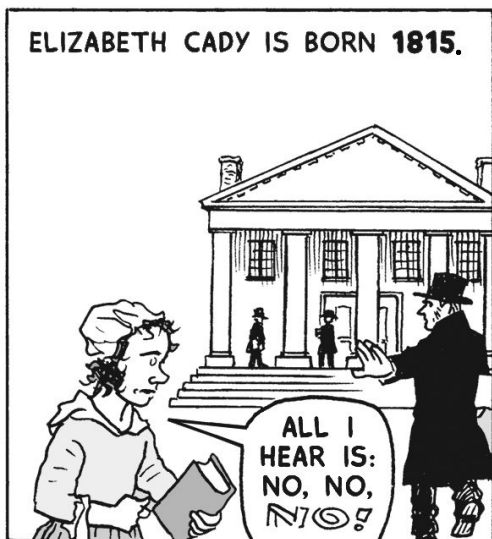

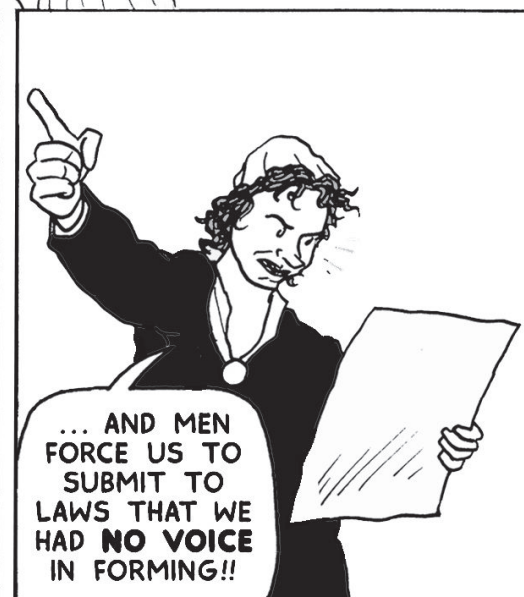
BIRTH OF A MOVEMENT

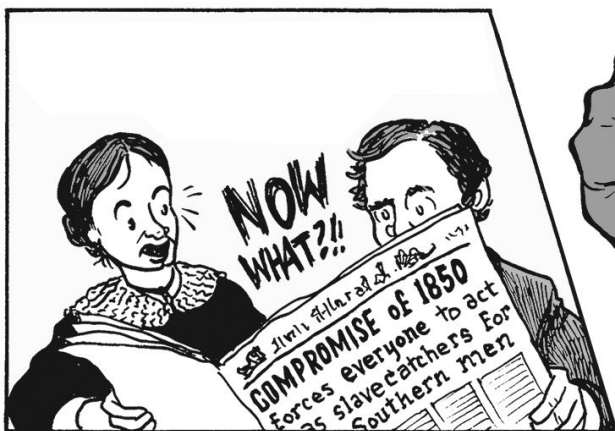
